Sleeping Arrangements

- Children sleep in rooms ranging from 4-10 children
- Bunk beds
- Bathrooms in most rooms

- Staff rooms that separate boys' and girls' rooms



Mealtimes

- Tuesday - all children with a need a snack and packed lunch in a disposable bag
- Two course evening meal on Tuesday and Wednesday
- A full English and/or continental breakfast is provided on Wednesday and Thursday
- A cooked lunch on Wednesday and a packed lunch on Thursday
- Children's supper of hot chocolate, cakes or biscuits
- Unlimited tea, coffee, squash or water is available on a self-service basis 24 hours a day
